How does the artist want you as the audience to react? Does this match how you think the general public will react?







What does this artwork tell you about society? Does this art represent a political stance?






How do text and other focal points play a role in how you view these pieces? How do all these elements explain the world at the time of creation and now? The same?








How do Luzzolino and Kraft's work differ?
