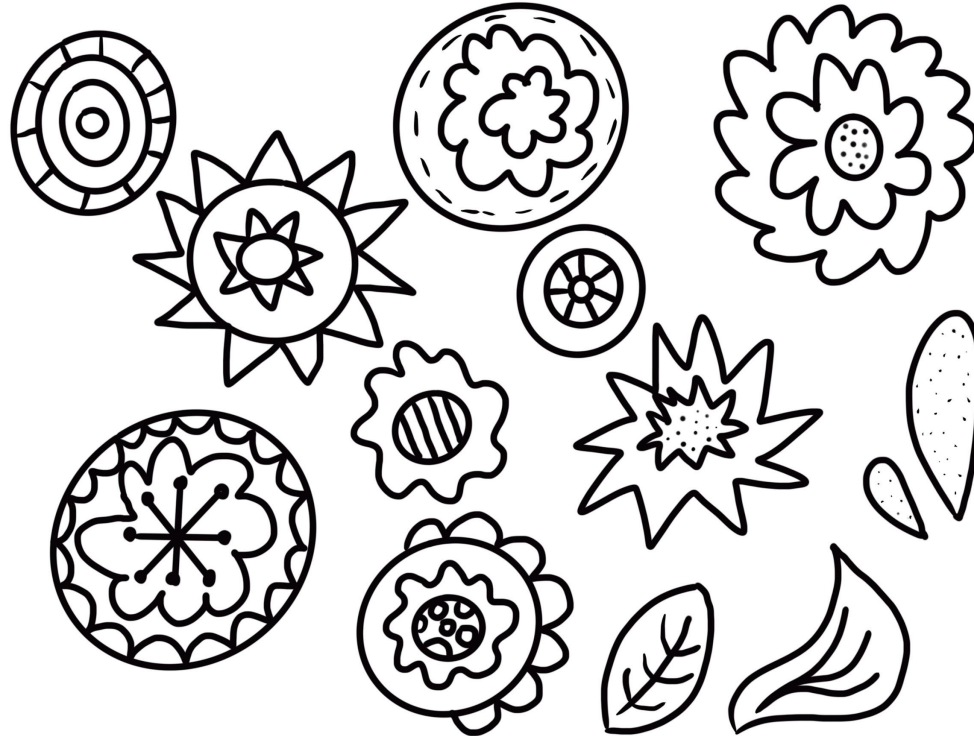
What do you think the mood of her work is? Look at the images in the next slide.





Our Project - Heather Galler inspired Bouquets!

- Start by drawing out 5 practice flowers - some examples are below!



Follow along on a seperate piece of drawing paper!

1. Look at the flower hand out given to you for flower inspiration
2. Draw 5-8 flowers
3. Flowers should be on the top half of your paper
4. Draw with pencil first, then black sharpie



Add a Vase

1. Add a vase - the vase should be an inch or two from the papers edge
2. You can put the vase **UNDER** some of the bottom flowers
3. Pencil first and then black sharpie



Add a Table

1. Add a table
2. Your table should go half way up your vase
3. Add a pattern
4. Pencil first and then black sharpie



Color!

1. Time to start coloring!
2. You can color or paint your flowers! Use whatever coloring materials you would like
3. Stay neat
4. Do not color the vase, table, or background



Ta-Da!

1. Paint/color the background 1 solid color
2. Paint/color the vase and table
